Programme Package Itinerary



Day Programme Descriptions



Tschenten Hike

Today we will head for a hike up Tschenten, the mountain that towers over the town of Adelboden and is the main viewing piece from Our Chalet. The hike up the mountain leads up a narrow path to a height of 1900m, which is high enough to certify for your Our Chalet Challenge Hike! After taking a rest break on the peak of Tschenten, where there are amazing views along the Engstligen Valley, we will hike back down to Adelboden along the new Discovery Trail. Officially known as "schutz.wald.mensch" (protection, forest, people) this is the perfect way to see how nature is so central to people's lives in mountain regions. The trail consists of Eight interactive information points cover the themes "falling rocks", "flooding", "avalanches", "landslides", "forestry", "long-term projects", "taking part" and "forest insights". Moreover, there are four visual points (natural phenomena and protective measures).

Engstligen Hike

To begin the day we all walk from Our Chalet to the magnificent Engstligen Waterfall, which is the second highest in Switzerland and during winter used for ice climbing. After a tasty BBQ lunch in the forest there is the option of taking the "Klettersteig" up, a well secured climbing route on which you will be guided by a professional mountain guide, or taking the cable car up onto the Engstligenalp, the 2000 m high plateau. Alternatively you can hike up the mountain. Engstligenalp has won a place in the 1996 Swiss Cultural Survey as a place of national significance. Here we all take a short stroll and admire the view before taking the cable-car back down the alp. (One-way trip on Gondola is paid by Our Chalet).



Adventure Park & Silleren Hike



This is definitely a fun day to test your skills with our two planned activities. First we all hike from Our Chalet along the valley and the Engstligen River until we reach the Rehärti Adventure Park! Under the guidance of Adelboden Alpine School instructors you can have a go at flying across the river with a zip wire, navigate your way across rope bridges and abseil off of a bridge, an activity for all. Following this adventure we will walk to Bergläger Station where we will take a gondola up to the top mountain observatory called Sillerenbuhl. Here you get one of the best views of the Swiss Alps; a sight you will never forget. Afterwards you have three different options about how to make your way back down the mountain to Bergläger before returning to the Chalet. You can choose between scootering down, hiking down the Vogellisi trail or taking the Berglager gondola back down (own cost).



Overnight Hike



The overnight hike to Bonderspitz is integral to the history of our Chalet. Bonderspitz is a mountain famous to the local people which overlooks the Adelboden Valley. On this overnight hike we will depart from Our Chalet after the evening meal and hike up to the Bonderlen plateau above Our Chalet. Here we will stay overnight with Thilde and Jacob, our local cheese makers. You will sleep above their cheese hut and have a hot chocolate to mark your arrival. At 3:00am we will wake and continue our hike up to the peak of Bonderspitz. You will be rewarded at 6 am with an amazing sunrise and view over Adelboden and Kandersteg valleys. We will eat breakfast here before hiking down to Kandersteg valley.

Kandersteg

From the overnight hike you will walk to the neighbouring valley of Kandersteg, a valley with distinctively different scenery to Adelboden with amazing steep mountains and a narrow main valley. It offers glacial areas, skiing and water fun on the picturesque Oeschinesee lake. Kandersteg is also home to the Kandersteg International Scout Centre, the world centre for the World Organisation of the Scout Movement. After our overnight hike we will rest our legs over lunch at the scout center, and then enjoy a guided tour of the facilities. In the afternoon we will catch a bus back home to Our Chalet.



Day Off

After the fun of the overnight hike and a busy week you will appreciate this day off! On your day off you can either relax and enjoy the atmosphere of Our Chalet and Adelboden or you can organize a day trip for your Troop. Our Chalet is happy to recommend the following places to visit and things to do:

Woodcarvers Hike & Rock Climbing/Abseiling



Today we will hike to the famous Adelboden Woodcarver; see him carving and have the chance to purchase some unique goods. Don't forget to bring a badge of your area for the badge ceiling of the

family! Afterwards you can taste the delicious lemon cake and hot chocolate in the nearby Café Blatti (own cost).

Whilst on this hike you will also get the opportunity to see the Choleren Gorge. See how the rushing river has carved and formed the gorge in this canyon like rock. Depending on the weather, the second activity of the day gives you the chance to participate in outdoor rock climbing at Adelboden Climbing Wall or abseiling in the Choleren Gorge. Alpinschule Adelboden offers qualified guides and all the necessary safety equipment. Following this you will have the opportunity to stroll through the village of Adelboden to see an authentic Swiss Village before returning home to Our Chalet.

Our Chalet Tour

After your arrival come and learn about Our Chalet with a new electronic presentation on the history and an introduction to the Our Chalet song! You can learn about the current status of Our Chalet and the progress we are making. We will then take you on a tour of the main aspects of Our Chalet. CD players are available but we do not have cooking facilities or the ability to use electronic presentations. At the end of the evening we have time for badge swaps with guests and our international staff.

This evening programme is the perfect combination of having fun and learning to know the Chalet and its grounds better. Our volunteers will provide you with funny, interesting and challenging questions and tasks to complete around and about Our Chalet, and the most efficient and thorough team will be rewarded!

Swiss Cultural Night

Whilst in Switzerland take part in this unique opportunity to learn more about your host country! Come along and experience some Swiss culture with a Swiss quiz, some authentic alphorn music and of course chocolate fondue tasting!





Campfire & Closing Ceremony

No Guiding or Scouting experience would be complete without the traditional Our Chalet campfire. General Information

Travelling to Our Chalet

The closest international airports to Our Chalet are Geneva or Zurich airports. From either airport you can catch a train to Frutigen where you can transfer to a red AFA bus to arrive at Adelboden Oey, Our Chalet's closest bus stop. To find out about train and bus times and fares please visit the Swiss Transport website (www.sbb.ch/en). If you are traveling with a group of 10 or more guests you must inform AFA buses (info@afa-busbetrieb.ch) 24 hours in advance.

Arrivals

Your group will be able to check in from 2:00pm on your arrival day. Guests arriving earlier can store their luggage at the Chalet, but cannot access their rooms earlier. During 9am to 6pm Our Chalet offers a luggage transfer service from Oey bus stop to Our Chalet. The cost of this service is CHF 4 per person one way. If you wish to utilize this service please inform Our Chalet of the exact bus you will be arriving on at least two days prior to your arrival. Note that the bus stop you will need to get off at is **Adelboden Oey**; tell the bus driver you are traveling to Our Chalet. The luggage transfer service is only for luggage, guests will walk from the bus stop to Our Chalet. Alternatively if you do not wish to walk or are arriving outside of office hours you are welcome to book a taxi (Ph: 033 673 2848 or e-mail: bergmann.reisen@bluewin.ch).

Meals

- Dinner is at 6:30pm, late dinners will not be served. If guests are arriving late on the first day they will need to make their own arrangements.
- Any guests with dietary requirements must fill out a Dietary requirements form prior to arrival. The form is available at www.ourchalet.ch and in your programme package booking contract. Please return it via fax, email or post.
- Our Chalet has a vending machine for drinks and snacks.
- Coffee, tea and hot chocolate is always freely available!

Budget

Remember to include the following expenses in your budget:

- Transport to Our Chalet (rail tickets, bus tickets)
- Travel and Health Insurance
- Internet access (CHF 5 every 15 minutes with a CHF 10 deposit).
- Laundry (CHF 5 washing machine and CHF 5 tumble dryer)
- Pocket money for personal expenses (e.g., Our Chalet souvenirs!)

Money

Switzerland uses the Swiss Franc (CHF). All of our prices are quoted in Swiss Francs and this is the currency that all shops, including Our Chalet's own, will use. Credit cards can be used, but incur a 2% surcharge and cannot usually be used for purchases under CHF 10 or in smaller shops. Travellers cheques can only be cashed at banks. For bill payment Our Chalet will accept cheques, travelers cheques, US Dollars and Euros, but please note we will calculate the exchange rate for you on the day that you pay. Our Chalet is unable to provide you with cash, but you can get this from Adelboden Town where several 24 hour ATMs are located.



Insurance

It is the responsibility of your group to ensure that you have adequate insurance for activities at Our Chalet. We do not provide insurance for you, nor can we answer questions about this, you will need to get in touch with your national organization.

Laundry Facilities

Our Chalet has self service guest laundry facilities. The cost is CHF 5 to use the front loader washing machine (soap included; 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hour cycle), and CHF 5 to use the tumble dryer (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hour cycle). Each load can hold a maximum of 5 kilos. These facilities are shared by all guests staying at Our Chalet

Our Chalet provides pillows and duvets/quilts, complete sheet sets and a set of towels.
